## The Year in Review - 2009

### January 2009

- Peggy Crismond processes orders for 59 boxes of supplies and equipment sent in January to 43 mission labs. We are thankful for the many mission travelers who hand-carry orders from WWLAB to the field month after month!
- Janet Clawson, a Medical Technologist from Michigan, comes to WWLAB for training in preparation for bringing equipment to Kissy United Methodist Hospital in Sierra Leone and training their staff.

### February 2009

- John Brashler has the unique opportunity to live on the Mercy Ship for a week while servicing their equipment.
- Ed and Carol Bos travel to Thailand to participate in the CMDA medical education conference for missionary physicians serving in Asia. While there, they are surprised to receive the Barnabas Award from Kudjip Nazarene Hospital in Papua New Guinea in recognition of WWLAB's partnership with and encouragement of the hospital staff.
- 48 shipments to 35 missions.

### March 2009

- John Brashler brings new testing to the lab at Univer Medical Centre in Haiti.
- Garry Thompson sets up the lab at the new CURE International Hospital in Honduras.
- A Medical Technologist from Switzerland serving in Asia comes to WWLAB for training. What a treat it was for all of us!
- 65 shipments to 31 missions.

### April 2009

- Ed Bos sets up the lab at the Centre Medico-Social, a Luke Society ministry in Senegal.
- 60 shipments to 34 missions.

### May 2009

- John Brashler teaches 6 students from two Seventh Day Adventist Hospitals in Nigeria how to do 15 new tests that will strengthen the ministries of these hospitals.
- Ed Bos travels to Haiti for a site-visit at the new Kings Hospital.
- 86 shipments to 43 missions.

### June 2009

- Ed Bos brings new testing to Tansen Mission Hospital in Nepal. Marianne Brocqueville joins him to train the staff in their native tongue! The lab can now perform testing that was available only in the capital city, 10 hours away.
- 70 shipments to 48 missions.

### July 2009

- Garry Thompson brings new testing to Zimba Mission Hospital in Zambia, a ministry of the Wesleyan Church.
- 52 shipments to 38 missions.

### August 2009

- Ed Bonvillian, a Medical Technologist serving at Koutilia Hospital in Mali, spends several days at WWLAB training on new analyzers to carry back to the field. We rejoice in this new friendship!
- A team from the Diocese of Joliet, IL spends a day at WWLAB for training in preparation for their visit to Naivasha Hospital in Kenya.
- 70 shipments to 38 missions.

### September 2009

- John Brashler spends 2 weeks traveling around Haiti to assist 5 mission labs with equipment repair and training – and enjoys friends from previous visits.
- 63 shipments to 36 missions.

- Ed Bos sets up the new lab for Gamboula Mission Hospital, a ministry of the Evangelical Baptist Church in Central African Republic.
- 51 shipments to 44 missions.

We are thankful for another year full of the Lord's blessing on this ministry as we assist those serving in Jesus' name in medical missions around the world.

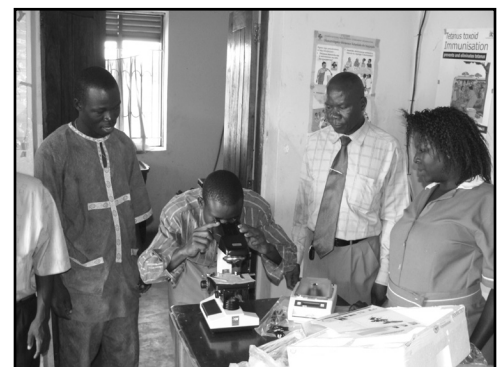
