The following email arrived from Dr. Ousmane Soh at Centre Medico-Social, a ministry of the Luke Society in Senegal, after Ed recently visited them to repair equipment and provide additional training for the lab staff.

i praise God for your life, and praise Him for our partnership, thank you for what you are doing in our ministries. everything is now working perfectly, this October we have 203 patients to Lab!!!!

today morning i had one patient who came for 40 kms on the way of Touba (that is the way we travelled this time to Dabra), Touba is one of the major cities now in Senegal, and it only about less than 20 kms from his village, but his friends and family told him to come to Dabra! to our clinic!

80 years old man, complaining of upper abdominal pain and vomiting, immediately i requested CPK, which was 658u/l, EKG showed inferior myocardial infarction!!!

since 2002 in Libya, i did not have that combination; upper abdominal pain (epigastric), EKG changes and high cardiac enzymes!!!! and that took place in middle of the african savana, almost out of no where!! do you remember how that lady doctor in Thies (the second largest and most important city in senegal) was exited to know the lab works we do in Dabra?!!!!

when you think of that you will realized how i am thankful to you and to the Luke Society, but above all to the King of kings and Lord of lords,

The “CPK” and “high cardiac enzymes” to which Dr. Soh referred are lab tests that were not available to him until we had the privilege of partnering with The Luke Society to provide them at this clinic in 2009.
